Peter has a vision. He is arrested but is set free from prison by an angel.

Paul, Peter and various leading Christians write letters to several communities, including different Christian churches in a number of cities.

Peter and Paul are both executed. c.64–67 CE and c.67–68 CE

The Romans destroy the temple in Jerusalem. 70 CE
